General Studies Transfer Equivalents

To transfer to the Graziadio School of Business and Management's Bachelor of Science in Management program, a student must have earned an acceptable grade point average on 68 or more transferable semester units from a regionally accredited college or university. Students should be employed on a full-time basis or have significant prior work experience in order to relate to the other students and the material covered in the course. Final decision of transferable courses will be made by admission representatives at the Graziadio School of Business and Management, Pepperdine University.

AREA 1: ENGLISH COMPOSITION

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to application for admission to the BSM Program)

AREA 2: MATHEMATICS

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to application for admission to the BSM Program)

MATHEMATICS 140, 150, 160, 170, 180, 180H, 185, 219, 219H, 280
SOCIAL SCIENCE 219, 219H

AREA 3: ARTS AND HUMANITIES

(At least 3 courses = 9 semester units from Area 3)

All courses listed in the General Education requirements for Area A1: Oral Communication, Area A3: Critical Thinking, and Area C: Arts, Literature, Philosophy, and Foreign Language for CSU GE-Breadth; **OR** Area 1B: Critical Thinking-English Composition, Area 1C: Oral Communication, and Area 3: Arts and Humanities for IGETC, **OR** the additional courses listed below:

ENGLISH 220

AREA 4: SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE

(At least 4 courses = 12 semester units; **one** course for 3 semester units **must** be in US History or American Government)

The following courses meet the U.S. History or American Government requirement:

HISTORY 118, 120, 120H, 121, 121H
POLITICAL SCIENCE 101, 101H

The remaining nine units (3 courses) can be taken from courses listed above or all courses listed in the General Education requirements for the AA degree under Area B: Social Sciences; **OR** Area D: Social, Political, and Economic Institutions and Behavior; Historical Background for CSU GE-Breadth; **OR** Area 4: Social and Behavioral Sciences for IGETC; **OR** the additional courses identified below:

AREA 5: PHYSICAL AND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units)

All courses listed in the General Education requirements for the AA degree under Area A: Natural Sciences; **OR** Area B1: Physical Sciences and Area B2: Life Science for CSU GE-Breadth; **OR** Area 5: Physical and Biological Sciences for IGETC, OR the additional courses identified below:

CHEMISTRY 12A, 12B, 106

AREA 6: LIFELONG LEARNING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Additional 15 GE units to satisfy the minimum 45 units GE requirement may be drawn from any of the above subject areas **PLUS** (four-unit limit in each category for classes marked with “*”, remaining units classified as electives; six-unit limit in each category for classes marked with **, remaining units classified as electives):

AREA 7: ELECTIVES

An additional 23-35 semester units of course work from Areas 1 to 6 above **PLUS** AA major preparation courses. Other courses not listed above that are applicable to the AA degree may be reviewed for applicability as electives. Students are encouraged to take courses from any business-related area to enhance their preparation for the Graziadio School's BSM program.

In addition, the following courses have been articulated so as to provide an option for students to WAIVE UP TO 12 UNITS OF BSM COURSE WORK, thus reducing the residential units to be taken at Pepperdine to 48 units. A minimum of four additional elective units are required for each four-unit courses waived.

- Grade B or better in ACCT 101 or 101H (4) **and** ACCT 102 or 102H (4) to waive ACCT 472 Accounting (4)
- Grade B or better in ECON 120 (3) **and** ECON 121 (3) to waive ECNM 469 Managerial Economics (4)

Note that students who waive any of the above courses in the BSM program and who subsequently enroll in the MBAJ program will be required to complete the equivalent MBA core course.
