GENERAL STUDIES TRANSFER EQUIVALENTS

To transfer to the Graziadio School of Business and Management's Bachelor of Science in Management program, must have completed a minimum of 60 transferable semester units with an acceptable grade point average from an accredited college or university or from approved sources prior to application. These transfer units must fulfill at least 45 units of general studies requirements including English composition and mathematics. Students should be employed on a full-time basis or have significant prior work experience in order to relate to the other students and the material covered in the course. Final decision of transferable courses will be made by admission representatives at the Graziadio School of Business and Management, Pepperdine University.

The note could state: Please note: Courses taken from Areas 1-7 including English Composition and Mathematics count toward fulfilling the 45 units of general studies requirement.

AREA 8: ELECTIVES

An additional 23-35 semester units of course work from Areas 1 to 6 above **PLUS** AA/AS major preparation courses. Other courses not listed above that are applicable to the AA degree may be reviewed for applicability as electives. Students are encouraged to take courses from the following areas to enhance their preparation for the Graziadio School's BSM program: **ACCOUNTING; BANKING AND FINANCE; BUSINESS; BUSINESS INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY; HOSPITALITY; MARKETING.**

In addition, the following courses have been articulated so as to provide an option for students to WAIVE UP TO 12 UNITS OF BSM COURSE WORK, thus reducing the residential units to be taken at Pepperdine to 48 units. A minimum of four additional elective units are required for each four-unit courses waived.

- *Grade B or better in ACCTG 1 (5) and ACCTG 2 (5) to waive BSM 472 Accounting (4). Students may take ACCTG 21 and ACCTG 22 with B or better grades in lieu of ACCTG 1.*

- *Grade B or better in ECON 1 (3) and ECON 2 (3) to waive BSM 469 Managerial Economics (4).*

Note that students who waive any of the above courses in the BSM program, and who subsequently enroll in the MBAJ program will be required to complete the equivalent MBA core course.

Bus 5, Business Law (3), and Bus 6, Advanced Business Law (3)
