To transfer to the Graziadio School of Business and Management's Bachelor of Science in Management program, a student must have earned an acceptable grade point average on 68 or more transferable semester units from a regionally accredited college or university. Students should be employed on a full-time basis or have significant prior work experience in order to relate to the other students and the material covered in the course. Final decision of transferable courses will be made by admission representatives at the Graziadio School of Business and Management, Pepperdine University.

(At least 4 courses = 12 semester units; one course for 3 semester units must be in US History or American Government)

AREA 5: PHYSICAL AND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units)

All courses listed in the Area A: Natural Sciences for West Los Angeles Graduation Requirements OR Area B1: Physical Universe or B2: Life Science for CSU GE requirements OR Area 5: Physical and Biological Sciences for IGETC.

AREA 6: LIFELONG LEARNING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Additional 15 GE units to satisfy the minimum 45 units GE requirement may be drawn from any of the above subject areas and those courses listed under Area E: Lifelong Learning and Self-Development (except Pers Dev 20 and 40) for West Los Angeles Graduation Requirements **PLUS** the additional courses identified below. There are unit restrictions for courses in ART, DANCE, MUSIC and THEATER not included in Area 3 of this Agreement – additional units in these areas count toward electives.

AREA 7: ELECTIVES

An additional 23-35 semester units of course work from Areas 1 to 6 above **PLUS** AA/AS major preparation courses. Other courses not listed above that are applicable to the AA degree may be reviewed for applicability as electives. Students are encouraged to take courses from any business-related area to enhance their preparation for the Graziadio School's BSM program.

In addition, the following courses have been articulated so as to provide an option for students to WAIVE UP BSM COURSE WORK, thus reducing the residential units to be taken at Pepperdine to 52 units. A minimum of four additional elective units are required for each four-unit courses waived.

- Grade B or better in ACCTG 1 (5) and ACCTG 2 (5) to waive ACCT 472 Accounting (4). Students may take ACCTG 21 and ACCTG 22 with B or better grades in lieu of ACCTG 1.
- Grade B or better in ECON 1 (3) and ECON 2 (3) to waive ECNM 469 Managerial Economics (4).

Note that students who waive any of the above courses in the BSM program and who subsequently enroll in the MBAJ program will be required to complete the equivalent MBA core course.
